The data is in the M1 Standard MIDI File .mid format. You can send them from the computer to the M1 and M1R using suitable DAW or MIDI submission software. Before sending data to the M1 or M1R, please make sure that the internal data is backed up.

First of all, you will certainly want to get to know all the programs and combinations. Do this extensively and try out everything you can think of. Give the sounds the opportunity to develop, as some effects are only noticeable when you let a sound fade out over a longer period of time.

Test the dynamic expression possibilities of the various controllers, use different playing styles and be inspired to create new song ideas. If you are already familiar with synthesizers and your Korg M1 in particular, then modify the sounds according to your personal preferences and habits.

In addition to the touch dynamics, controllers take on numerous special functions to make your music very expressive. The sound-changing controllers can be used both live and for sequencer recordings in the simplest possible way and apply to all styles of music. This gives you countless variations for every sound program.

The sound change itself is programmed for each sound in such a way that, for example, moving the joystick as far as it will go produces the maximum musically sensible effect intensity. The controller functions are programmed as standardized as possible for optimum handling. Each of the following controllers provides you with at least one of the musical expression elements mentioned:

• Aftertouch: Volume, Brilliance, Modulation

Pitch Bend up: Pitch, Brilliance
 Pitch Bend down: Pitch, Brilliance
 Joystick up: Modulation

• Joystick down: Effect Modulation

Accordingly, some controllers are always programmed with the alternative that seems particularly useful musically. The brilliance of a string section, for example, can be controlled with the pitch bender, while pitch bending is possible for a lead sound. The controller application applies to programs and combinations. The application allows you particularly lively playing possibilities that will be the envy of all!

You can also connect a foot pedal to your instrument as a controller and use it to create sound-shaping effects while playing. You can find information on this in the operating instructions for your synthesizer.

Important note:

The sound programs are equipped with the exclusive LCS identification system, so that you have the manufacturer's guarantee that you are holding a professional and error-free software product in your hands with the original SysEx and .mid data.

It is best to make a backup copy of this data for your own work before using it for the first time, so that you always have the original data available in the event of data loss. Further copies of the data is not permitted. Unauthorized copying of the bitr-store sound programs is a violation of copyright law and can be prosecuted under criminal and civil law.

The use of the sound programs for private and public use in form of music, soundtrack for film, multi media production use is licensed with the purchase of the original data.
